Anthony DeCaprio Jr., 91, of Greenport, passed away Saturday May 14, 2022. Born January 7, 1931 in Hudson, NY, he is the son of the late Anthony and Philomena (Esposito) DeCaprio Sr.

Anthony grew up in Hudson and graduated from Hudson High School. Upon graduation, Anthony enlisted in the United States Air Force where he honorably served during the Korean War from 1950-1954. Anthony was employed as a lab technician at the former Lone Star Cement Plant, he then continued his career in the maintenance department for the Hudson City School District from which he retired. He was a communicant of the Church of St. Joseph Stottville, and was a former member of the Knights of Columbus. Anthony was best known for his kindness, friendly manner, and showing neighborly care for others. He always had a story to tell, and his sense of humor was displayed to the very end. Anthony's favorite hobbies were photography and free hand drawing.

Anthony is survived by his beloved wife and best friend Frances (Graziano) DeCaprio. Together they supported and cared for each another for 56 years. He is also survived by several nieces and nephews, and his Goddaughter Anna DeCaprio. Anthony was predeceased by his sisters Mary C. Pizza and Rose Leach, and his brother James DeCaprio.
