Hudson-Anthony C. Tiano, 81, of Hudson, died Thursday at Columbia Memorial Hospital. Born July 13, 1935 in Hudson, he is the son of Joseph and Mary (Carpino) Tiano.

Tony was a lifelong Hudson resident where his careers included Floor Supervisor at various Hudson clothing factories, and Administrator of Hudson Moose Lodge #1184 for over 30 years. His commitment and dedication to the Moose Lodge earned him the Degree of Pilgrim. Tony was also a 4th Ward Alderman in Hudson, and in recognition for his lifelong community service he was awarded "The Key to the City of Hudson". Tony served in the United States Air Force from 1953-1958. He was loved by all who encountered him, and will be most remembered for his great sense of humor.

Survivors include his companion Sharon Groves of Hudson, daughters Cathy Alvey and Jennifer Tiano both of Bellaire, Ohio, sisters Teresa Miller of Valatie, and Margaret Risch of Hudson, and brother Ralph Tiano of South Carolina. Tony is also survived by 3 grandchildren, several great grandchildren, many nieces and nephews, and a large extended family who will cherish his memory. Tony was predeceased by his son Johnny Tiano, and brothers Charles, Frank, Tommy, and Louie Tiano, and sisters Rose Graziano, Laura Ames, and Mary Cullen.
