Arnold "Charlie" Doty, 86, of Hudson, passed away Wednesday, August 15, 2012 at his residence.

Born February 21, 1926 in Hudson, he was the son of the late Harold and Winifred (Finch) Doty.

Charlie worked for the City of Hudson in the Department of Public Works. He also worked on several horse farms in the area. He loved horses, camping, and the great outdoors. Charlie was a great story teller. He was a member of the VFW and the Drum and Bugel Corp.

He served in the US Navy during W.W. II and was a survivor of the S.S. Twiggs, which was destroyed. Charlie enjoyed going to the Navy Reunions.

He is survived by his wife, Rose (Madison) Doty; two sons, Brian Doty of Livingston and Charlie Doty of Valatie; his brother, Raymond Doty of Hudson; his sister, Dorothy Slater of Kingston; five step-children, William Weaver of Churchtown, Trudy Weaver of Hudson, Sheila Leccese of Hudson, Bertha Rae Decker of Niverville, and Adam Lackmann of Hudson; many grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

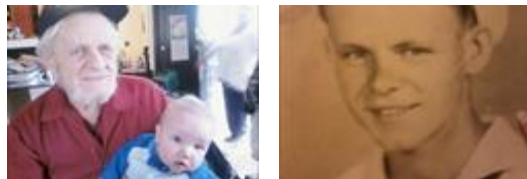
