October 11, 1926 - September 24, 2018

Barbara Rose age 91 passed away Monday September 24, 2018 in Seattle Washington at her daughter's home, surrounded by family.

Barbara Dorothy Sack was born October 11, 1926 in Philadelphia PA to Leo and Lillian Wilen Sack. She was the youngest of 4 children. The Sack family moved to Hudson NY in 1931. Barbara graduated from Hudson High in 1944. When she was 15 she met her future husband Joseph Rose at a dance in Kingston NY. Five years later (with a brief separation while Joe served in the 8th Airborne during WWII) they married. They lived in Trenton New Jersey until Joe graduated college, then moved to Kingston New York where their first child was born. In 1951 they moved to Hudson where they lived for more than 40 years.

Barbara's family was the center of her world. She also loved animals, always had pets and, in Florida, was involved in animal rescue. She loved to entertain and play golf with Joe and friends. Her love of people and fashion, led to the opening of Barlyn, with her sister-in-law Linda Pearson. Barlyn's success gave her tremendous pleasure. She loved being active (riding her bike on her 90th birthday) and loved to laugh (she was a terrific joke teller).

Barbara and Joe retired to Florida where they lived for more than 20 years until Joe passed away in 2010, 4 months shy of their 63rd anniversary. In

2012 Barbara moved to Voorhees NJ to be closer to family. She loved meeting new people and made friends wherever she went. In 2016 she moved to Seattle to be near her daughter. She lived in a senior residence where she enjoyed walking, Zumba classes, dining out, theater, concerts and much more.

Barbara was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Joe, her brother Meyer Sack (Lee), and her sisters Ruth (Herbert) Singer and Mildred (Stanley) Alpert. She is survived by her children Jeffrey (Paulina), Susan (Donna Darm) and Marcy, her grandchildren Jonathon and Andrew Rose and many nieces and nephews all of whom she adored. She was a life-long member of Congregation Anshe Emeth in Hudson.

Funeral services will be held at Bates and Anderson Funeral home at 1 pm Thursday September 27th, 2018, followed by a gravesite service at Cedar Park Cemetery. Shiva will be observed by the family at the home of Barry Sack.
