Catherine E. Klimek, 79, of Ghent, passed away Monday, December 10, 2012 at Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Born July 26, 1933 in Hudson, she was the daughter of the late John and Catherine (Lemmermann) Burfeind.

After graduating from High School, Catherine went to school in New York City to become a medical secretary. She enjoyed her years working for the World Health Organization in New York City, where she met different kinds of people from all over the world. After returning to this area, she worked for the Rip Van Winkle Clinic and for several doctors including Phillip Incao, MD of Harlemville.

Catherine was a lifelong member, and dedicated member, of St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Hudson, where she volunteered in the food pantry. She worked diligently to help resettle several Vietnam refugees into the US. Catherine loved animals, especially her cats.

Catherine was the beloved wife of 48 1/2 years of Charles F. Klimek of Ghent; devoted mother of Peter E. (Wendy) Klimek of Chatham, Stephen A. (Nancy) Klimek of Ghent, Ilona M. Klimek of Ghent, and Cheryl (Timmy) Burrall of Florida, and loving sister of Henry (Sandy) Burfeind of Ghent. She is also

survived by several grandchildren, and many aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, and nephews.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by a daughter, Maria Carole Klimek and a brother, Walter J. Burfeind.
