Charles Burton June, 98, of Philmont, passed away peacefully January 24, 2019. He was born on October 26, 1920 in Columbiaville, to Burton Simon and Myrtle Eva (Taylor) June. He grew up in Stockport, and was a member of the Stockport Fire Company from 1938 to 1942. On June 27, 1942 he married Mildred F. (Ham) June, and just shy of two months later he was inducted into the United States Army. Having earned the rank of Corporal Duty NCO as a Military Police Officer, he was honorably discharged in 1945. He returned home to settle with his wife in Philmont, where he resided until his death. He worked for many years at the Highrock Mills as a Cloth Handler. Then after semi retiring he worked doing part time custodial help at both the Key Bank and the United States Post Office. Charles was active in the Philmont community volunteering at the Philmont Nutrition Center, serving as treasurer for the Friendship Club, a member of the Minkler Sery Post, and he was a member of the United Methodist Church of Philmont.

Surviving are his four children; Linda Burdick, Rebecca Bonesteel, Brenda Wisdom, and Charles A. (Paula) June. He is also survived by fifteen grandchildren, twenty four great grandchildren, and seven great-great-grandchildren. His one brother, Franklin D. June, and several nieces and nephews also survive him.

In addition to his parents Charles is predeceased by his wife, Mildred June, his two daughters, Sherian Coleman and Nancy Bednar, granddaughter Shanal Coleman, in addition to three brothers and five sisters.

Funeral services will be held on February 1, 2019 at 12:00, Noon, from Bates & Anderson – Redmond & Keeler Funeral Home, 110 Green Street, Hudson. Interment will follow in Mellenville Union Cemetery. Visitation hours will begin at 10:00 AM also from the funeral home.
