Cheryl "Cheri" Evelyn Hudson, 78, of Greenport, passed away Monday August 17, 2020. Born July 8, 1942 in the Town of Greenport, she was the daughter of the late Arthur Griffith and Belle Griffith Clark. From a young age, she was raised by Marcus and Evelyn Scutt.

Cheri attended one of the last one room schoolhouses in Glenco Mills from kindergarden through 6th grade, graduating from Ockawamick School in 1960. From the day she graduated high school, she never stopped working. First as an apple packer, then at W.T. Grants, and at the first shopping center in Greenport in 1962. Cheri retired from Columbia Memorial Hospital in 2006, after 37 dedicated years as a unit secretary. She loved to organize dinner parties, and Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve celebrations for the entire hospital. She also enjoyed organizing co-worker parties, retired employee "get togethers", lunch and dinner with her husband Charlie, along with friends Jane, Edith, Pat, and Marge, with most of these gatherings taking place at Kozel's. Cheri enjoyed baking for Christ Church Episcopal luncheons, and for over 40 years baking Christmas cookies in February and sharing them with family and friends. She was so blessed to have her close friends, Tanya (deceased), Joyce, Helen, Mary Ann, Paula, and Terri. To a very special friend Connie who has been there for me through all the good and bad times. Cheri is the beloved wife of her husband of 58 years, who she loved with all her heart, Charles Hudson. She is survived by her brothers Arthur (Nancy) Griffith, and Larry (Bel) and Scott (Donna) Clark, and her cousin Marcus
