Christopher Filli, loving husband, father, son, and sibling, passed away on Friday, January 12, 2024 in Hudson, New York while on duty serving the community he loved so dearly. Born on January 19, 1973, Christopher is the son of Theodore and Jacqueline (Slominski) Filli. He attended St. Mary's Academy, St. Patrick's in Catskill, and graduated from Hudson High School upon both Academies closing. Following graduation, he attended Zone 14 Police Academy at Columbia-Greene Community College. Christopher's law enforcement career started with the Copake Police Department and the Philmont Police Department. In October of 2001, he was hired by the Hudson Police Department and became a School Resource Officer in September, 2005. His exemplary service earned him a promotion to Detective in 2008, where he served in the Juvenile and Narcotics Unit. Christopher was then promoted to Sergeant in 2017 and Senior Sergeant in July, 2022, where he served until the end of his watch. When he wasn't serving and protecting the City of Hudson, he enjoyed his second career as proprietor of Chris Filli & Son Tree Service Inc. [L] [SEP] Chris will be forever loved by his parents Theodore "Ted" and Jacqueline Filli, his siblings Theodore Jr. (Carmen) of North Carolina, Brian of Claverack, Dana of Claverack, Damon (Ashley) of New Lebanon, Brendan (Amanda) of Kinderhook, Kyle (Suzanne) of Valatie, and aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins. He created two beautiful children, Christopher Jr. and Abigail (Tobi), with his first wife Denise. The family was blessed with Angelia in 2013. Chris married the love of his life Megan in 2018,

and they shared eight wonderful years together and three beautiful children: Kylie, Leighton, and Nico. Chris was happiest when he was with his family and friends. They will all remember him for his signature smirk and daily weather reports. Chris was tirelessly devoted to his wife and children, as he cherished every moment he spent with them. Chris is also survived by his father-in-law Michael (Dianne) McHenry and mother-in-law Linda (Brian) Stumbaugh. “Who’s Packing Your Parachute?”

My Wife Barbara, and I, would like to share a story that was sent to us by a friend. I think it captures the spirit of what its been like knowing Christopher Michael Filli during the past 51 years. I hope it impacts you as it did us.

Charles Plumb was a US Navy jet pilot in Vietnam. After 75 combat missions, his plane was destroyed by a surface-to-air missile. Plumb ejected and parachuted into enemy hands. He was captured and spent six years in a communist Vietnamese prison. He survived and now lectures on lessons learned from that experience.

One day, when Plumb and his wife were sitting in a restaurant, a man at another table came up and said, “You’re Plumb! You flew jet fighters in Vietnam from the aircraft carrier Kitty Hawk. You were shot down!”

“How in the world did you know that?” asked Plumb. “I packed your parachute,” the man replied. Plumb gasped in surprise and gratitude. The man pumped his hand and said, “I guess it worked!” Plumb assured him, “It sure did. If your chute hadn’t worked, I wouldn’t be here today!”

Plumb couldn’t sleep that night, thinking about that man. Plumb says, “I kept wondering what he had looked like in a navy uniform; a white hat; a bib in the back; and bell bottom trousers. I wonder how many times I might have seen him and not even said “good morning, how are you?” or anything- because, you see, I was jet fighter pilot and he was just a sailor. Plumb thought of the many hours the sailor had spent at a long wooden table in the bowels of the ship, carefully weaving the shrouds and folding the silks of each chute, holding in his hands each time, the fate of someone he didn’t know.

Now, Plumb asks his audience, “Who’s packing your parachute?”

Everyone has someone who provides what they need to make it through the day. He also points out that he needed many kinds of parachutes when his plane was shot down over enemy territory – he needed his physical parachute, his mental parachute, his emotional parachute, and his spiritual parachute. He called on all of these support systems before reaching safety.

Sometimes in the daily challenges that life presents us with, we too often miss what is really important. We may fail to say hello, please, or thank you, congratulate someone on something wonderful that has happened to them, give a compliment, or help with a just cause. We would like to share this story with everyone who knew or knew of our Nephew, Christopher Michael Filli, as our way of thanking him for the many times he packed our parachutes during the past 51 years-----hoping that you, too, will pack the parachutes of those individuals who helped pack yours!
