Dale Rowe, 77, of Mellenville, passed away Thursday September 23, 2021. Born October 10, 1943 in Hudson, he is the son of Edward and Vivian (Myers) Rowe. A lifelong Columbia County resident, Dale graduated from Ockawamick High School in 1962. He continued his studies at SUNY Cobleskill, earning an Associates Degree in 1964. Dale worked for over 40 years at the Columbia County Department of Health, serving as Environmental Health Director for 20 of those years. Dale was a Life Member of the Mellenville Fire Co., serving as Assistant Chief, CCVFA Chairman, delegate to the County Convention, and Sergeant of Arms of the Color Guard. He was also a former Taconic Hills School Board member, and Board Member of the Philmont Rod & Gun Club. Dale enjoyed hunting, fishing, and trapping, and loved his loyal companion Rocky. He was also an accomplished artist known for his landscapes on sawblades.

Dale will be forever remembered by his son Sean and daughter in law Michele, daughter Courtney Hutchings and son in law Dan, grandchildren Madison, Zachary, Hunter, Jaxon, Ava, and Ella, and nieces Jessica Chiera and Jene Sena. In addition to his parents, Dale was predeceased by his wife Barbara (Hamm) Rowe.
