Daniel M. Theiss, 84, formerly of Durham, died Monday, March 14, 2011 at the Firemen's Home in Hudson.

Born March 12, 1927 in Rensselaer, he was the son of the late Henry J. and Anna (Hartman) Theiss.

Dan was the owner and operator of Dan's Electrical Service in Durham. He served in the US Navy during WW II, earning the American Theatre Medal and the Victory Medal.
