



Dorothy Holsapple

January 7, 1921 - April 24, 2014

Dorothy Holsapple, 93, formerly of Hudson, died Thursday, April 24, 2014 at Northern Dutchess Hospital in Rhinebeck.

Born in Hudson on January 7, 1921, she was the daughter of the late Frank Burdwin Holsapple and Harriette (Palmer) Holsapple.

She graduated from Hudson High School in the Class of 1938 and was later the office manager of the Rockefeller Foundation in Rockefeller Center until her retirement. She lived in New York City for many years before moving to The Woods in Rhinebeck. She lived at Arbor Ridge in Rhinebeck at the time of her death.

She was active in The Church of St. John in Rhinebeck and previously at Christ Episcopal Church in Hudson. She enjoyed life, including her many friends, the arts, travel, opera and gardening.
