



## Edward F. Card, Sr.

August 20, 1917 - April 15, 2015

Edward F. Card Sr., 97, of Claverack, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 15, 2015 at Pine Haven Nursing Home in Philmont.

Born in Philmont on August 20, 1917, he is the son of the late Wilmer and Edna (Coons) Card. He was also predeceased by his wife, Helen (Korobchuk) Card.

Ed is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Edward F. Card, Jr. and Susan Howard-Card of Warwick NY; three grandsons, Justin Card, and his wife, Niccole, and their daughters, Analise and Camryn, of Warwick, Matthew Card, and his wife, Shanan, and their daughter, Payton (and expecting another daughter in June) of Claverack, and Daniel Card of Warwick; two brothers, Stanford (Edna) Card of Claverack and Robert Card of Philmont, and two sisters, Effie Braunfels of Philmont and Tassie Gent of Valatie.
