Edward P. Jackowski, 80, of Columbiaville, passed away November 22, 2012 at Columbia Memorial Hospital surrounded by his loving family.

Born July 2, 1932 in Hudson, he was the son of the late Anna (Majewski) and Joseph Jackowski, Sr.

Ed was a professional bowler for over 30 years at Hendrick Hudson Lanes. He bowled 3 perfect games during his career. Ed was president of the Junior Bowling Program at Hendrick Hudson Lanes for many years, a member of the Columbia Greene Bowling Association Hall of Fame, and had several television appearances on the weekly bowling show "TV Tournament Time". He was an avid golfer and fisherman and a big fan of the NY Giants and the NY Mets. He played baseball in several Columbia County Leagues and was an animal lover, especially his cat "Chip Chip". Ed served in the US Air Force from 1949 until 1952.

Ed is survived by his companion of over 30 years, Mabel Miller of Columbiaville; two daughters, Ann Finck of Greenport and Jill Langan of Southampton, England; two brothers, John Jackowski of Freeport, IL and Joseph Jackowski of Beverly Hills, FL; four granddaughters, Piper and Zoe Langan of Binghamton and Tara and Morgan Libruk of Greenport, and a great-grandchild, Landon James Filli.

He was predeceased by his daughter, Susan Jackowski, in 2009.
