Edward Bernard Reynolds, 75, of Greenport passed away July 6, 2018 in Catskill, NY. Born April 25, 1943 in Bronx, New York he is the son of Thomas Reynolds and Sarah Higgins. Ed attended All Hollows High School, in Bronx New York and graduated with the class of 1960.

Ed worked over 30 years for Citibank. He began his career as a window teller in the early 1960s and worked his way to become Executive Vice President of International Investments at Citicorp Center in Manhattan.
