Francis "Frank" A. Mastrianni III Obituary Frank A. Mastrianni III passed away on October 1 2024 surrounded by his loving family in his home in Claverack, New York, after a two year battle with glioblastoma, a brain cancer.

Frank was born on November 18, 1961 in Albany, New York, and was the son of Frank Mastrianni Jr and Diane Daus Mastrianni, both now deceased. He was raised in Mechanicville, New York, and he graduated from Mechanicville High School in 1979 and graduated from Siena College in 1983 with a degree in Accounting.

Frank began working for New York State Tax and Finance nearly 30 years ago, starting as an auditor, but spending the last ten years of his career as a Director of the Business Contact Center Division of New York State Taxation and Finance.

Frank was highly gifted at math and enjoyed the challenge of Sudoku puzzles, the statistics involved in gambling, and helping friends and family get their finances under control. The apple of his eye was his only child, Gina (Marcus) and he was thrilled to know that he was going to be a grandpa of a baby girl at the end of October. He loved to golf, --especially with his father,---winning several tournaments in his past. Frank was Mechanicville Golf Club Champion in 1982, '84, '85 & '86. He enjoyed simple pleasures in life such as birdwatching on the back deck with a cup of coffee and his cat Mitzy on his lap, taking drives in the northeast countryside with his wife, Andrea, and

splitting a chocolate milkshake with his daughter, Gina. He enjoyed “spa days” with his sister Denise, and enjoyed reminiscing about the past with his brother, David. Gina’s mother, Debbie Bell (Freddy), remained an important part of his life and she was there at his passing.

Frank leaves behind his wife, Andrea, his daughter Gina (Marcus Widmer) Mastrianni, his granddaughter to be, His sister, Denise Mastrianni (Jim), and brother, David Mastrianni. His stepchildren, Jillian (Daniel) Atlas and Andrew (Jackie Curley) Spiciarich and three step grandchildren Oliver, Olana, and John Joseph (JJ) and two nieces Kathleen (Matt) O’Brien Caroline (Sam) Mastrianni and great niece Shay O’Brien.
