Frank Charles Skrocki, 94, of Hudson, NY, passed away peacefully with his family by his side, Friday March 8, 2024. Born in Hudson, New York in 1929, he is the son of Polish immigrants, Joseph and Sophie (Kucharzyk) Skrocki.
