Genevieve Konosky died the morning of her 94th birthday in Whittier Nursing Home. Genevieve was born in Carbondale , PA, on November 17, 1918, the fifth of nine children - three sisters and four brothers died previously. She was predeceased in death by her husband, Paul Konosky.

She is survived by a daughter, Mary Baer of Port Charlotte, FL, one sister Rose Lauer of Schertz, Texas, three granddaughter's, Susan Baer of Ghent, NY, Heather Rozelle of North Port, FL and Emily Baer of Stuyvesant, NY; four great grandchildren, Gavin and Darah Miller and Ashlyn and Hayley Rozelle, and numerous nieces and nephews.

She lived in NYC, Ridgefield, NJ, and Lake Havasu City, Arizona prior to moving to Columbia County . She loved to travel and drove cross country by herself several times.

The quintessential lifelong volunteer, she volunteered in New Jersey for the Red Cross, March of Dimes, and was president of the Ridgefield NJ High School PTA. In New York she helped found the Widowed Persons Service in Columbia County, and assisted with the Edith Casey Stocking Fund for many

years. She was also a member of the Red Hat Society and the women's auxiliary of the Washington Hose Co.

In her early days she ran PK Purveyors with her husband, which was a wholesale meat business delivering to fine restaurants in NYC. When she was in Arizona she was a real estate agent for Caravan West and managed Casa Blanca Apartment Complex. Then she worked at the Hudson Day Care Center as their bookkeeper until she was 80 years old.
