Geoffrey T. Bagnall, 64, of Livingston, died Thursday, March 28, 2013 at Columbia Memorial Hospital.

Born September 1, 1948 in Queens, NY, he was the son of Dorothy and Thomas H. Bagnall, Jr.

Geoffrey was the Captain of the Nassau County Police Department for over 20 years and a former Police Commissioner from 2000-2002. He was the owner of Sweeps in Hudson for 24 years. He was a member of the Widow Sons Masonic Lodge in Livingston and a member of the Kalicoontie Rod & Gun Club.
