



Glenn Robert "Bobby" Anderson

September 3, 1961 - May 6, 2024

Glenn Robert "Bobby" Anderson, 62, passed away peacefully on Monday, May 6th, at Albany Medical Center after a brief illness, with his loving family by his side. He was born in Hudson, NY, on September 3, 1961, to Janice (Hoose) Anderson and the late Harold Glenn Anderson and grew up in Mellenville, NY.

After graduating from Taconic Hills High School in 1979, Bobby pursued his passion for business at Columbia-Greene Community College. He inherited his father's love for cars, which led him to establish and operate Anderson Motor Car Corp. for over three decades across Hudson and New Lebanon, NY. Whether he was towing vehicles with his cherished tow truck, maintaining his lot to perfection, watching countless hours of NASCAR, or attending racing events at Lebanon Valley Speedway, Bobby's life revolved around cars.

Bobby was renowned for his storytelling prowess, his tales echoing throughout town, and his ancient flip cell phone ever glued to his ear. His absolute greatest source of pride and joy, and focus of many of his stories, were his sons, Brett and Blayne, whose achievements in the annual demolition derby and the car industry he boasted about endlessly. They are his enduring legacy.

In the latter years of his life, Bobby found solace and companionship in Amy,

his steadfast partner. Her unwavering support and encouragement were his pillars of strength, particularly during his final days.

Bobby is survived by his mother, Janice; life partner, Amy Donlon; sons, Brett (Phoebe) Anderson and Blayne (Eden Pottenburgh) Anderson; grandchildren, Harper and Kennedy Anderson, and "Baby Anderson," arriving soon. Bobby also leaves behind his sisters, Jill (Lou) Tuczynski and Jennifer (Anthony) Anderson Browe, and his nieces, Talika (Nick) Tuczynski-Wait and Alexandria Browe.

In addition to his father, he is also predeceased by his nephew, Jay-Jay Tuczynski.

Visitation hours will be Saturday, May 11, 2024 beginning at 1:30 p.m., with a funeral service following at 4:00 p.m. Both will be held at Bates & Anderson - Redmond & Keeler Funeral Home, 110 Green Street, Hudson, NY. Burial will follow at Mellenville Union Cemetery off of NY State Route 217.

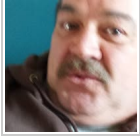
