KINDERHOOK – Glenn D. Simmons, a licensed barber and former proprietor of the Simmons Barber Shop, Greenport, died suddenly Thursday, March 12, 2015, at his home.

A Columbia County native, Glenn was born November 1, 1943, the son of John and Edith Drobner Simmons.

He was a graduate of St. Mary's Academy, Hudson, and American Barber Institute of Schenectady, after which he opened his own shop in the former Simmons Plaza, Route 9, Greenport, which he operated for more than a decade. He also was a licensed barber in Florida.

Glenn later was employed by Skyline Corporation and spent many years as a salesman for various automobile dealerships in Albany and Columbia counties.

He is survived by his wife of more than 50 years, Judith (Adams) of Kinderhook; a daughter, Suzanne Turner of Port Orange, FL.; two grandsons, Matthew and Joshua Turner, both of Florida; a sister, Sheila (Harvey) McCagg of Stockport; and a brother, Daryl (Sue) Simmons of East Lyme, CT.; and

several nieces and nephews.

Glenn was an ardent fan of NASCAR, particularly Dale Earnhardt Jr., enjoyed wood-working and gardening, and was a loving father and grandfather.

He was a member of Kinderhook Elks Lodge 2530 and St. John the Baptist Catholic Church of Valatie.

Funeral services will be held at St. John the Baptist Church at 11 a.m. Monday. Interment will be in the Stuyvesant Falls Cemetery.
