



Harold Hallenbeck

October 20, 1921 - June 23, 2017

Harold F. Hallenbeck, 95, passed away June 23, 2017, at Pine Haven Nursing Home. He was born October 20, 1921, in Hudson, New York, to Howard and Edna (Decker) Hallenbeck. A graduate of the Class of 1939, St. Mary's Academy, Harold served as a radio mechanic in the Air Transport Command Division of the Army Air Corps during World War II, stationed in the China-Burma-India Theater.

Harold worked for 37 years for the State of New York, Department of Mental Hygiene, in Albany, before retiring in 1983. He was an avid Yankees baseball fan, and a member of the Flying Dutchmen club and softball team.
