Helen Macheski 1922-2013

Helen Macheski, of Hudson, passed away Thursday, October 17, 2013 in Rhinebeck.

Helen Macheski was born in Fort Smith, a tiny outpost in Canada's North West Territories. After an adventurous few years up north, the family moved to Alberta, where she grew up and later met Andrew Macheski, an American soldier stationed on a training base during World War II. They married and moved to Brooklyn, New York, where they lived for many years and raised four children. Helen worked as a professional seamstress, and enjoyed making clothes for her family and herself. After she was widowed, she moved to Hudson, New York, and became an active member of St. Mary's Church, joining the Christian Service committee and the Catholic Daughters of America. She spent her final years at the Thompson House in Rhinebeck, receiving attentive and personal care. She is survived by a sister, Mary, and three of her children: Sylvia, Cecilia and Arthur Macheski. She will be greatly missed.

A wake will be held on Sunday, October 20 from 2 pm until 5 pm at Bates and Anderson Funeral Home, 110 Green Street, Hudson. A Mass will be celebrated at 10 am on Monday at St. Mary's Church in Hudson, followed by
