Hyman P. Miller died peacefully at home on Thursday, July 9, 2015, after a long battle with cancer.

Hy was the owner of Sam's Supermarket from 1974 until its closing. He was also a member of the Hudson Rotary Association, and a former member of the Board of Directors of the Hudson Area Association Library.

The son of Samuel Miller and Rose Colton Miller, he is survived by his wife Deborah, his children Sam and Sarah, and his sons-in-law Juancy Rodriguez and Eric Talent. In dying, as in living, Hy was full of positivity and happiness and inappropriate humor, and in fact his last words were "Nobody's dying today."

Services will be held at Bates & Anderson Funeral Home in Hudson on Sunday, July 12, at noon. In lieu of flowers, the family asks that donations be made in Hy's memory to the place that treated him so well for so long, New York Oncology Hematology, 69 Prospect Avenue, Hudson NY 12534.
