Irving G. Ostrom, Jr., 81, of Columbiaville, passed away May 20, 2022 with his loving family by his side. Irving was born October 31, 1940 in Boston Corners, New York. He was the son of Grace (DeGrosso) and Irving Ostrom.

Irving grew up in Copake, New York. He married his wife Beverly Ferry and raised three children Pamela, Frederick and Patricia. Irving proudly served in the United States Army, where he guarded the Berlin Wall while stationed in Germany. He was a lifetime member of the Greenport Firehouse Pump # 1 and also a life member of the Federation of Polish Sportsman. Irving was a hard worker. He worked at the Universal Match Factory until its closing, then he went to work at the Brookwood Secure Center where he retired at age 62. That lasted for a month. Irving had to do something to keep busy. He started to work two days a week at the county transfer stations. He continued to work until he was diagnosed with cancer in 2020.

Irving is predeceased by his parents Irving and Grace Ostrom, sister Elizabeth Flanagan, brother John (Jack) Hotaling and granddaughter Kayla Bleau. Irving is survived by his loving wife Beverly Ostrom, children Pamela (Michael) Bleau of Kinderhook, Frederick Ostrom of Columbiaville and Patricia Gregory (John Smith) of Lake City, SC, two sisters Pearl Mossman of Philmont, Beverly Walsh of Hudson, three grandchildren Heather Gregory, Tyler Gregory and Kyle Bleau and one great grandchild Baleigh Smith.

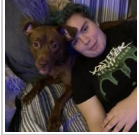
