James Nero, 81, of Hudson, NY passed away Friday November 3, 2023. Born July 30, 1942 in Hudson, he is the son of Domenico and Michelina (D'Onofrio) Nero.

Jim graduated in the 1961 class of Hudson High and attended Colona Beauty School. Jim was a master barber and had several shops in Hudson prior to retiring, the last being Genesis Unisex Hair Designers. Genesis was more than a hair shop it was a Hudson gathering place many times likened to Cheers.

Jim spent 4 years and 4 months in the United States Navy. Almost all of time was spent in service on the USS Lake Champlain, the last of the straight-edged deck carriers. Just several months ago he enjoyed the annual USS Lake Champlain Reunion in Virginia Beach.

Jim's #1 priority was always family. He was proud of his Italian heritage and many of our favorite memories involve sauce and meatballs. He fielded many requests a year for his famous pepperoni. Jim's other passion was travel. He and Roberta traveled to Italy many times and traveled Europe and the Caribbean extensively. Only last year he traveled to Italy with the extended Nero family. There were several trips of a lifetime including two trips to French Polynesia and a trip to Easter Island.

Community involvement was very important to Jim. He was a Life member of V.F.W. Post 1314, Hudson Elks Lodge #787, the Columbia County Sons & Daughters of Italy, and the Federation of Polish Sportsmen. Jim was also a 50 plus year member and Past President of J.W. Edmonds Hose #1 (Oldest active volunteer fire company in NYS).

Jim is survived by his beloved spouse Roberta "Bert" Moseley Nero, devoted sons and daughters in law, Joseph C. and Lisa Nero and James P. and Jessica Nero, cherished granddaughters Samantha M. and Wilhelmina G. Nero and several nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, Jim was predeceased by all of his older brothers, Antonio, Joseph, Anthony and Louis Nero.

Funeral services will be Wednesday November 8, at 1:00 from the Bates & Anderson-Redmond & Keeler Funeral Home. Visitation hours also at the funeral home will be Tuesday November 7, from 3:00-7:00pm.
