James W. "Schemy" Schermerhorn, 80, of Ancram, passed away Wednesday July 31, 2024 at his residence. Born September 12, 1943 in Hudson, NY, he is the son of Ralph and Marcia (Rivenburgh) Schermerhorn.

Schemy enlisted in the United States Army in 1962 and served until he was Honorably Discharged in 1966. 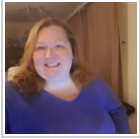
