He is survived by his wife Adrienne Lewis, his son Samuel Lewis (Abby) his sister Barbara Sheiken (Burt), his brother Paul Bernstein (Jane), nieces Mardie Sheiken, Dannie Sheiken, Elise Wisman (Foster) and nephew Jordan Bernstein (Chelsea) and great-nieces Emma, Leah and Sophie and many friends and neighbors.
