Jennie Anna Kenas, 96, of Spook Rock Road, Claverack, died on March 4, 2020 at Columbia Memorial Hospital. Born in Elizaville, NY, she was the daughter of the late Ignacy and Agnes (Kostek) Jarocki.

Jennie graduated from Germantown High School, and was a 1945 graduate of Hudson City Hospital School of Nursing, during which time she was in the U.S. Cadet Corps. She retired from Columbia Memorial Hospital in 1985 after practicing as a Registered Professional Nurse there for 40 years.

Jennie was a parishioner of the former Sacred Heart Church and thereafter a communicant at St. Mary's Church in Hudson, Holy Trinity Parish. She was a member of Our Lady's Sodality of Sacred Heart, and the Claverack Garden Club where she served as past president, historian and member of the executive board. She received her greatest enjoyment when working with flowers and plants.

Jennie is survived by two daughters, Joanne Endres of North Rensselaer, and Teresa Kenas of Hudson; two sons, Joseph Kenas of Kunkletown, PA and Paul Kenas of Portsmouth, VA; as well as eight grandchildren, ten great-grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her beloved husband Bernard Kenas. In addition to two brothers, Henry and Stanislaw, and three sisters, Stanislaw, Stella

Jarocki of Hudson, and Stefania Kazukenus of Albany.
