John H. Harp III , 74 of Greenport, passed away Tuesday July 23, 2019. Born September 4, 1944 in Hudson, he is the son of John H. and Elsie (Rivenberg) Harp Jr.

John was Honorably Discharged from the United States Army where he served from 1965-1968, earning a Vietnam Service Medal and Good Conduct Medal. After serving his country, John furthered his education earning a degree as an LPN where he practiced at Albany Medical Center. 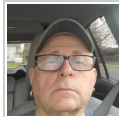
