John N. Loos III, 76, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on June 13, 2024 at Albany Medical Center. John was born August 20, 1947 in Hudson, NY to the late John N. Loos and Edith Columbo (Smith).

John graduated from Hudson High School class of 1965. He then served with the U.S. Navy in Vietnam from 1967-1969 and was honorably discharged. John worked at the Universal Match Company for 18 years until they closed in 1988. He later retired from Columbia County DPW.

He was a life member of the Disabled American Veterans and of the Stuyvesant Falls VFW Post 9593 where he served as a commander from 1993-1994. He was also a life member of Phoenix Hose number 5 of the City of Hudson. John took pride in being one of the founders who helped place the Vietnam Veteran memorial at the Columbia County Courthouse.

John loved classic cars, oldies music, the NY Giants and NY Yankees and reminiscing of days past. Most recently in 2019 he enjoyed a trip to Washington D.C. with the Patriot Flight where he viewed the memorials and most importantly to him, the Vietnam Memorial where he was for the dedication statue in 1984.

Joann and her husband Ronnie Wendover, cousins Roger Seymour and Frederick "Skeeter" George.
