Joseph Henry Colwell, devoted husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather passed away at the age of 96 in what he referred to as God's Country, Columbia County, NY, residing at the Firemen's Home in Hudson, NY. Joseph is survived by his wife Mary of 73 years, his daughters Carol Rosenberg (Michael), Janice Patrie (Jeffrey), four grandchildren, seven great grandchildren, sister in law, brother in law, as well as many cousins, nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his siblings Lillian and Matthew.

Joe proudly and honorably served as a US Marine in the Pacific Theater from 1943-1946. His time in the service prevented him from attending his high school graduation ceremony. Following the war Joseph joined the Hudson Police Department and retired as a Sergeant in 1973 after twenty plus years of service. Joe was a valued member of the J.W.
