Joseph A. Sacco, 94, of Greenport, passed away Thursday March 25, 2021, in Albany, NY. Born May 31, 1926 in Stockport, NY, he is the son of Joseph and Carmela (Gramoglia) Sacco. Joe was Honorably Discharged from the United States Navy serving from 1944-46 aboard the USS Bottineau.

His career was a mason with the Bricklayers Union Local #6 of Albany, then with NYS Parks and Restoration for 10 years. Joe worked on the many mansions within the Hudson Valley maintained by NYS Parks Taconic Region. He was also well known in the area as a skilled mason who would always put his trademark penny within the structures he built or repaired.
