Seeking a change, Julie, after visiting the city once, moved to New Orleans where she worked as an archivist, a psychic and licensed tour guide. She was well respected for her psychic abilities and was, more than anything, an empathetic listener to many people who sought her out. Julie lived in New Orleans for nearly 20 years, a city that she adopted and, in turn, loved her. Her “family” there supported her and her interests: art, music, poetry, performance. This was also where she adopted Mu, her cat companion of 14 years. Together, she and Mu, made countless trips back to Hudson, so as not to miss any of the family get togethers.

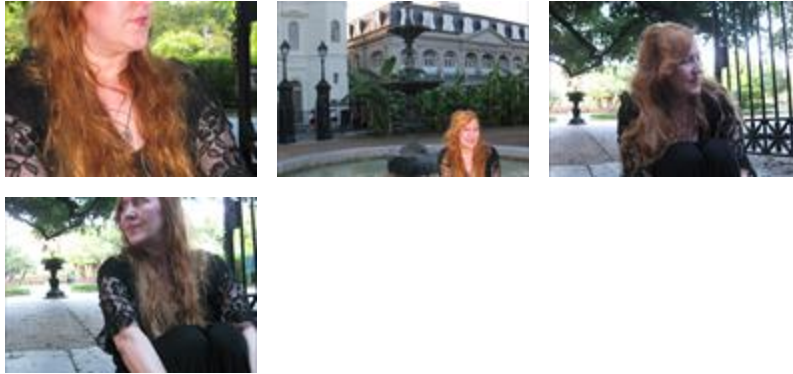
RIP Julie. May you find eternal peace among the stars. You will be missed and never forgotten.
