Kenneth Andreas Huber, 78, of Ghent, passed away on Friday, July 8, 2011 at home after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Ken was born July 11, 1932 in Brooklyn NY to Johanna (Miller) and Frederick Huber. In 1949 his family moved away from the city to Spencertown, NY, where they owned and operated a dairy farm. In 1950 Ken graduated from Chatham High School . In 1953 the family bought another dairy farm and moved to West Ghent NY . Ken joined the US Navy serving from 1953 until 1957. He was aboard the USS New Jersey, and served in the Military Police. He returned home and continued farming with his brother Fred.

He was instrumental in building The Heritage House in Troy, The Cohoes Rehabilitation Center and The Beverwyk Retirement Community. He retired from Northeast Health in 2005.
