



## Louis A. Curcio, Sr.

Louis A. Curcio, Sr., 88, of Ghent, passed away Friday, December 7, 2012 at Hospice at Columbia Memorial Hospital surrounded by his loving family.

Born November 17, 1924 in Hudson, he was the son of the late James and Minnie Curcio.

He served in the US Army during World War II with the Company B 748th Railroad Operation Battalion. He earned the Good Conduct Medal, the Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal, and the World War II Victory Medal.

Lou was the owner and operator of Lou's Barber Shop in Philmont for over 40 years, but had been a barber for over 60 years. He was a member of the Ghent Fire Company for over 40 years, a member of the Philmont American Legion, and an honorary member of the Philmont Rescue Squad and the Philmont Fire Company.
