Louis H. Snow, Sr., of Ghent, died Friday, February 13, 2015 at Albany Medical Center.

Born June 14, 1946 in Hudson, he is the son of the late Wilhelmina (VanDerBisen) Snow and Robert Charles Snow, Sr. He attended Ockawamick Central School. He served in the US Army from 1968 to 1970, where he earned the Good Conduct Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, Expert M-16 Badge and Sharpshooter M-14 Badge. 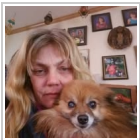

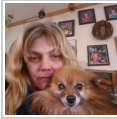
