Louis G. Taylor, 59, of East Taghkanic died Sunday May 5, 2013 at St. Peters Hospital in Albany.

Born July 3, 1953 in Hudson, NY, he is the son of the late George and Mary (Finger) Taylor. He is survived by his (step) mother, Betty Taylor of Castleton, who was an important part of his life.

Louis was a postal clerk at the Hudson NY post office. Louis served his country in the United States Marine Corp honorably from 1972-1984, achieving the rank of Chief Warrant Officer. He was also a member of Hudson Elks # 787, and a member of Hope Church in Lenox, MA.
