Luella B. McGetrick, 97, formerly of Ghent, passed away Thursday, July 11, 2013 at the Firemen's Home in Hudson, where she had been a resident since 2005.

Born January 7, 1916 in Martville, Cayuga County, she was the daughter of the late Christa and Hannah Schrader. Luella was one of 11 children and was raised on the family homestead in Weedsport. She was the owner and operator of McGetrick's Bridal Shop in Ghent. Luella was a charter member, and life member, of the Ghent Ladies Auxiliary.
