Luke Whitbeck died peacefully at home in the loving care of the staff at Lake Street in Valatie on Saturday, February 21, 2015. He was 47 years old.

Luke led a very full and happy life. He was enrolled in the first pre-school for handicapped children, The Happy Day School, in this area. In the Special Olympics he excelled and won awards in swimming.

He attended Hudson High School. There he developed his love of football as ball boy for the team and traveled with them to games. The Hudson Boys Club became his second home. He loved watching wrestling, playing his cd's and socializing.

Leaving home to live in Germantown and work at the COARC workshop in Mellenville, he experienced many years of friendships and wonderful mentors. He was well known and loved in the community and will be dearly missed by all he touched.

Luke was predeceased by his father, Harvey Whitbeck and his sister Patrice.

He is survived by his mother, Lenore, his brothers, Harvey, Stephen, Paul and John Whitbeck, his sisters, Jan Rhiner, Denise Whitbeck and Cynthia Hills, as well as nieces and nephews.

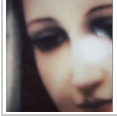
