Margaret (Ruso) Jablanski, 64 of Hudson, NY passed away April 29, 2020 in the comfort of her home surrounded by the love of her husband, family, and close friends. Peggi, as she is affectionately known was born April 20, 1956 in Albany, NY to George and Grace (Ryder) Ruso. As a young girl, the family moved to Niverville, where Peggi would graduate from Ichabod Crane High School Class of 1974.
