



Marian Lampman Stone

October 14, 1915 - April 11, 2016

Marian R. (Lampman) Stone, 100 1/2 years old, passed away peacefully at Francis House in Syracuse on Monday, April 11, 2016.

She was born in Hudson, New York to Franklin Leslie Lampman and Eugenia Louise Raymond Lampman. Marian graduated from Hudson High School and St. Luke's Nursing School in New York City, and then moved to Syracuse in 1936. She considered herself a nurse her entire life. She was an advocate for women issues, but stood up for rights of all.

She was predeceased by her husband, Theodore Fisher Stone, her son Peter Lampman Stone, and her sister Nathalie Elizabeth Lampman.

Surviving are her son, Philip T. (Suzanne) Stone of Syracuse, two daughters Nathalie S. (James) Buckley of Liverpool and Elizabeth F. Stone (Robert Smith) of Smithtown, a daughter-in-law, Sandra (Schmidt) Stone of Webster, 10 grandchildren, and 14 great grandchildren.

A memorial service was held on Saturday April 30th at Grace Episcopal Church in Syracuse, NY.

A private burial will be at a later time in Hudson, NY.
