Marion M. Dolfax, 102, of Greenport, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 27, 2012 at Whittier Skilled Nursing Center with her family beside her.

Marion was a colorful figure in Greenport having lived there for almost 75 years. She had many accomplishments in her lifetime. She served on the Greenport Planning Board for 25 years, retiring in 1997.
