Marge was a quiet and private person and was known for her stubborn streak! She was comfortable in her own home with her own routine. Marge not only survived the pandemic she often said she was made for a pandemic :) She frequently thought her children and their families were "crazy" for all their travel. She was a very determined individual. Marge surprised many by coming back from significant challenges that began in late 2019 culminating with Marge requiring a walker but found her way back from that to cruising the house in the past 2 years with no walker. In addition, most who knew her would say she had her best periods of clarity in a long time during that period. We all thought, including Marge, that she'd be with us until 100 as was the case with her mother and her mother's mother...We will all miss her.

Marjorie was predeceased by her late husband, Jim (who died prematurely at the age of 45). Marge was also predeceased by her parents, her brothers, William (Billy) and Richard (Richie), as well as her long-term companion of 33 years, Art Fuss.

Marjorie is survived by her daughter Denise (Adam) Gutstein and son Kevin (Aileen) Kitsock and 3 grandchildren, Grant & Trent Gutstein and Emily Kitsock as well as her brother Edward (Eddie) Hester, Jr and sister-in-law, Joan Galea.
