Martin Mottoshiski, 82, of Stottville, passed away Sunday, August 12, 2012 at his residence.

Born November 13, 1929 in Hudson, he was the son of the late Martin and Elizabeth (Stevens) Mottoshiski.

He was a locomotive engineer at the Atlas Cement Company for over 35 years and a member of the Silver Medal Club.
