Mary "Pat" (Brown) Osborn, 78, of Philmont, NY passed away Saturday December 2, 2023. Born May 22, 1945 in Hudson, she is the daughter of Anna Elizabeth (McKee) and William Gustav Brown. Mary, affectionately known as "Pat" or "Patsy" attended West Taghkanic one room school house for elementary, and graduated from Hudson High School.

Pat worked at Columbia Auto Parts as a secretary. That's where she met Richard "Ozzie" Osborn that became the one and only love of her life. They married in 1970 and moved to the Churchtown Reservoir house to raise their five children; Patty Osborn, Shannon Osborn, William Osborn and Richard's two children from a previous marriage; Ricky Osborn and Anita (Osborn) Bridgham. It was in their Churchtown home that friends and family enjoyed cookouts and the ultimate in country living, still revered by all to be the "best of life" memories.

At 17 years old, Pat received a cake decorating kit sent back overseas from her only sibling Kenneth William Brown who was serving in the United States Marine Corp at the time. This became the catalyst to a cake making hobby that evolved into a lifelong side career lasting for decades.

Pat created her children's Halloween costumes as well as the 1976 Hudson Bicentennial outfits fashioned of the era. Pat loved and adored her grandchildren, great grandchildren and most recently becoming a great great grandmother, completing 5 living generations. Pat will be remembered for her kindness, warmth and selflessness, often putting many others needs in front

of her own.
