Nancy Sumner Bristol passed away Wednesday, July 17, 2013 at the Eddy Village Green in Cohoes, NY.

Nancy is the daughter of Leslie Graham Sumner and Chrystabel Bartlett Sumner and was born May 23, 1923 in Hartford, CT. She attended schools in West Harford, CT and graduated from William H. Hall School.
