Nancy Meyer, 56, of Hudson, died April 9th, 2015 of cancer at St. Peter's Hospital in Albany.

Nancy was born in Catskill and graduated from Coxsackie-Athens High School and Columbia-Greene Community College.

She operated Festive Foods, a mobile food concession business, for many years throughout New York and New England. Nancy and her husband, John Meyer, founded East Coast Customs in 2001. Nancy also worked for over 20 years helping to improve the lives of families in Columbia and Greene Counties through her work at Greene County Community Action Agency, Greene County Head Start and Catholic Charities – WIC Program.

Nancy is survived by her husband, John Meyer, of Hudson, N, and her daughter, Heather Meyer and her fiancé Dave Winne of NYC. She leaves behind many nieces, nephews, loved ones and friends.

Nancy was a talented artist who will be remembered for her sense of humor and spirit of adventure. She was an inspiration to all who knew her.

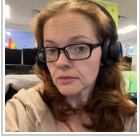

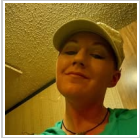
