Nicholas Paul Mossman, 63, of Philmont, passed away April 29, 2021 at Ghent Rehab and Nursing Center. He was born on May 3, 1957 in Hudson to Philip and Marie Mossman both who have predeceased him. His nine-year battle with many health issues has finally ended and he has found peace.

Nick served in the United States Air Force from 1977 – 1983 upon which he received an honorable discharge with the rank of Sergeant. He was an avid NY Yankees and Miami Dolphins fan. . Nick was a former Justice of the Peace for the Village of Philmont, and volunteer fireman in Mellenville.
