Patricia B. Wallace, 82, of Hudson, passed away November 12, 2019 at her home surrounded by family and friends.

Born February 25, 1937, daughter of George A. Hawver and Dorothy (Crosby) Hawver of Hudson, NY, Patricia graduated from Hudson High School in 1954. Throughout her childhood she was close to her cousin, the late Janet (Hawver) Slominsky. She had two younger brothers, George "Skip" Hawver of Black River, NY and Charles "Chuck" Hawver of Hudson.

She was married to the late Vincent J. Wallace, Jr. on January 25, 1957 at St. Matthew's Lutheran Church in Hudson.

Patricia held many jobs throughout her life, and began her thirty-plus-year career as a Physical Therapy Assistant at Barnwell Nursing Home in Valatie, NY in the late 1960s. She became a Registered Physical Therapy Assistant in the 1970s, an accomplishment she was very proud of. Throughout her career in Physical Therapy she also worked at Columbia Memorial Hospital in Hudson and Pine Haven Nursing Home in Philmont, retiring from full-time employment in 2002.

She also was a waitress at Cedar Meadows Restaurant in the late 1970s.

Throughout her life, Patricia resided in Hudson, Valatie, Claverack, and Greenport. She was active in the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Valatie Fire Department and the Claverack Fire Department.

She enjoyed gardening and tending the flower beds in her yard. She took great joy in creating original pieces of jewelry and giving them as special gifts to her family and friends. Known for her generosity and sense of humor, she never missed a birthday or a special event, and she never missed an opportunity to tell a joke or send a funny card or gift.

She was a highly dedicated and loving mother, grandmother and great grandmother.

She was a loyal friend to many.

Patricia is survived by her four children, Vincent G. (Ellen) Wallace of Hudson, Michael Wallace of Gorham, ME, Patricia K. Wallace of Hudson and Timothy Wallace of Williamstown, NJ. She is survived by 6 grandchildren, Robert A.
