Her aunt Elizabeth Lynk and cousins Mary Jones and Thomas Meltz not only helped Phyllis transition from independent living to Whittier, their continued presence and support throughout the years is greatly appreciated.

In addition to her parents, Phyllis was predeceased by a son, Brian M. Holdridge, who died at birth and several aunts, uncles and beloved pets.
